RESOLUTION DECLARING THE NEED FOR A HOUSING AUTHORITY IN PINELLAS COUNTY, FLORIDA, ADOPTED; COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR PUT IN FULL CHARGE OF PROGRAM; NAMES OF MEMBERS OF THE COMMITTEE TO BE INCLUDED AND RECOMMENDED FOR CONSIDERATION BY THE GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA

Pursuant to recommendation of the County Administrator, the following resolution was adopted: 65-143

RESOLUTION DECLARING THE NEED FOR A HOUSING AUTHORITY IN PINELLAS COUNTY, FLORIDA

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Pinellas, Florida:

THAT the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Pinellas, Florida, hereby determines, finds and declares in pursuance of the "Housing Authorities Law" of the State of Florida, that:

1. Insanitary and unsafe inhabited dwelling accommodations exist in the County of Pinellas, Florida; and
2. There is a shortage of safe and sanitary dwelling accommodations in the County of Pinellas, Florida, available to families of low income at rentals they can afford; and
3. There is need for a Housing Authority in the County of Pinellas, Florida.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Governor of the State of Florida, be promptly notified of the adoption of this resolution and is hereby requested to appoint members to serve as Commissioners of said Housing Authority pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 421.27 of the Florida Statutes; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall be effective immediately.

Commissioner Davis offered the foregoing resolution and moved its adoption, which was seconded by Commissioner Weatherly, and upon roll call the vote was:

In further action Commissioner Davis moved, seconded by Commissioner Anderson and carried, that the County Administrator be put in full charge of this program to see that it is properly organized and carried out to its completion; that this be brought before the public properly so that it can have the full support of the public; that the Board do everything possible to see that it is carried forward; that the names of the members of the Slum Clearance Committee be included and recommended for consideration by the Governor of the State of Florida for appointment to this Housing Authority; and that the Clerk transmit a copy of the resolution and the motion to the Governor of the State of Florida for his consideration.

Chairman Bonsey commented, referring to the portion of the motion regarding the names of the members of the Slum Clearance Committee, that it was his understanding that these would be the lay members of the committee. Clerk Harold Mullendore suggested that Commissioner Davis furnish a list of the names of the lay members. This list is as follows:
